## ABOUT THE SINGAPORE ENVIRONMENTAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

The SEEA, organised by the SEC, was first launched in 1997 by the former Minister for the Environment, Mr. Yeo Cheow Tong. Every year, the awards recognise organisations in South East Asia that have committed to environmental and social responsibilities.
